MEMBERSHIP RULES

- Membership of the SAP Higher Education and Research User Group is open to all degree-granting Higher Education and Research Institutions who are SAP customers with signed contracts for the productive use of one or more R/2 or R/3 software modules.
- Those Higher Education Institutions that are part of the SAP Tertiary Education Program in which R/3 is made available for inclusion in the curriculum for one or more academic modules or courses are **NOT** eligible for membership unless their institution also happens to be an SAP customer.
- Attendance at meetings of the HER User Group is open to all members and to HER Institutions that are "qualified SAP prospects." The right to vote at such meetings is restricted to member institutions.

MISSION AND GOALS

The overall mission of the HER User Group is to foster the development and more effective delivery of SAP functionality to the higher education and research community.

The HER User Group will act as a liaison between SAP and HER Member Institutions and between the Institutions themselves. It will work with SAP AG and its national subsidiaries in a collaborative manner so as to be:

- The route via which HER Institutions can communicate their mutual requirements and concerns to SAP
- A forum in which HER Institutions can agree on specifications for software development/enhancement requests to be submitted to SAP
- A grouping of resources for development of functionality that SAP has indicated that it will not develop itself
- A knowledge base forum where HER Institutions faced with similar problems can learn from each other and by sharing the Group's knowledge of implementation and functionality issues that are particular to the HER sector
- A forum to which SAP will communicate initiatives into the HER community
