

Erasmus Mundus Master of Science in Sustainable and Territorial Development (120 credits)

STeDe Master is a master level degree course and consists of 120 ECTS credits in two academic years (From October to August). All the courses and educational activities are offered by the four participating universities through a specific mobility scheme for the students: each participant will study in at least 3 different countries.

Common track for all students:

First semester: 30 credits - Università di Padova (Italy)

Second semester: 30 credits - K.U. Leuven (Belgium)

Third semester: 30 credits - Univ. Paris 1 Panthéon-Sorbonne (France)

Fourth semester: 30 credits - In one of the 3 European partner universities or at Univ. Catolica Dom Bosco (Brazil)

First semester - Università di Padova (Italy) - 30 credits

Second semester – Katholieke Universiteit Leuven (Belgium) - 30 credits

Communication, Culture and Knowledge – 3 credits (compulsory)

Spatial Management – min. 9 credits (choice - 3 subgroups)

Intercultural and Tourism Destination Management – min. 9 credits (choice - 3 subgroups)

Place/Destination Management Assignment – 9 credits (choose one option)

* Option Place Management (from Neighbourhood to Region)

* Option Destination Management (from Site to Landscape)

* Option Heritage, Tourism and Development

Third semester – Univ. Paris 1 Panthéon-Sorbonne (France) - 30 credits

Fourth semester - One of the 3 European partner universities or at Univ. Catolica Dom Bosco (Brazil) – 30 credits

Internship – 9 credits (compulsory)

Master Thesis – 21 credits (compulsory)
