

Master of Arts in Theology and Religious Studies (60 credits)

Theological and Religious Studies Courses

- Students choose a major and take the two courses on offer (8 credits).
- As a rule, students take also five courses from this group chosen from the fields outside the area of specialisation, one course per field (20 credits). One of these courses can be exchanged for a seminar (see 'Seminars').
- Students are free to take additional courses from this group as electives.
- Students who choose the major Biblical Studies, need to have a knowledge of Hebrew and Greek; for the major History of Church and Theology, a knowledge of Latin is required; for the other majors a knowledge of those languages useful and necessary with regard to the individual thesis work is required.
- Departments can - if necessary or desired and after consultation with the Teaching Committees - decide ad hoc to combine English and Dutch programme components.
