72 credits, compulsory.

1. Latin

The student takes one course of 4 credits.

2. Mgr. W. Onclin Chair

Onclin chair: The subject of the specific academic year is the obligatory subject (2 x 4 credits).

3. Canon Law Specialisation

Depending on the specific academic year the rotating courses of that specific year are obligatory (12 credits).

4. Electives

Canon Law Specialisation: Electives

Depending on the specific academic year, students choose 12 credits.

Electives Theology and Law

Students who studied Theology, select in the first course stage for at least 12 credits, course units from the programs of the Faculty of Law.

Students who studied Law and all other students, select in the first course stage for at least 12 credits, course units from the programs of the faculty of Theology.
